WASHINGTON, D.C., APR. 16, 1973 -- The Senate Interior Committee voted today to favorably report the nomination of Kent Frizzell to be Solicitor of the Department of the Interior.

Frizzell was introduced to the Committee by Senator Bob Dole who called Frizzell "a superb choice." Dole said that this nomination is "another clear example of the President's determination to vest responsibility in young, talented people at the highest levels of his Administration and to provide this Nation with the best possible quality of government."

Frizzell's wife, Shirley and son, Gregory, accompanied him to the committee hearing.

Following the favorable vote, Dole said he hoped Frizzell's nomination would be confirmed by the full Senate this week.
