WASHINGTON, D.C., MAY 9, 1973 -- Senator Bob Dole today announced the appointment of George W. Haley as Assistant Director of the United States Information Agency.

Haley, a former resident of Kansas City and member of the Kansas Senate, has been Chief Counsel of the Urban Mass Transportation Administration since 1969.

Dole called the appointment of Haley "an excellent choice and yet another indication of President Nixon's determination to bring ~~bring young~~ qualified individuals into the highest levels of his Administration."
