WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole today announced that the Senate Public Works Committee has approved plans for the \$18 million Topeka Federal Office Building.

"I am extremely pleased to learn that the Committee has moved so quickly to provide full clearance for this major Topeka project," Dole said.

The Committee's approval of the General Services Administration

prospectus completes the necessary Senate action, and only approval by the House Public Works Committee is needed before GSA can move ahead with site selection and additional steps toward construction.

"I have been in close contact with members of both the Senate and House Committeess and am hopeful that the House Committee can now act to remove the final obstacle to full speed progress on the building," Dole said.
