WASHINGTON, D.C -- Senator Bob Dole today announced he has been informed by the Corps of Engineers that camping and parking policies at Wilson Resevoir will remain substantially the same as in the past two years.

"The Corps of Engineers has recognized that insufficient developed camping space is presently available at Wilson Lake for all those who visit there. Therefore, they have agreed to permit continued use of traditional camping areas until enough developed sites are available," Dole said.

Dole added that formal publication of the policy is expected from Col. W.R. Needham of the Kansas City District Office within the next day or so.

The announcement follows a meeting held at Senator Dole's request last week between Wilson Lake campers and boaters and a representative of the Corps of Engineers.

Commenting on the policy Dole said, "I am pleased that the Corps has recognized the problems which have developed and has modified its policy in response to the peoples' needs."
