WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole will be attending the Angus Centennial Celebration in Victoria today. The Centennial celebration marks the introduction into Kansas 100 years ago, of the first Angus cattle brought by George Grant.

Commenting on the celebration Dole said, "At present the more than 50,000 cattlemen raising registered Angus and thousands more raising non-registered Angus, play a vital role in making beef of the highest quality a high-protein staple in the American diet, at a cost lower than anywhere else in the world.

"I am sure the Angus Centennial in Victoria will set the tone for a second century of the breed's contribution to the American way of life.
