WASHINGTON, D.C. — Senator Bob Dole has announced final passage of an appropriation bill containing \$18,000 for improvements on Dickens Avenue in Manhattan.

The \$18,000 funding provision must now gain the approval of the Senate-House Conference Committee since the Manhattan funds were not included in the House passed version of the Appropriations Bill.

Senator Dole said that he has been in touch with both Senate and House Conferees regarding the Manhattan amendment and it is hopeful that funds will soon be available for the badly needed road improvements.
