TOPEKA FEDERAL BUILDING

THE TOPEKA FEDERAL BUILDING HAS THIS MORNING BEEN GRANTED APPROVAL BY THE SENATE PUBLIC WORKS SUBCOMMITTEE ON PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS. THE PROSPECTUS NOW GOES TO THE FULL COMMITTEE WHERE ACTION IS EXPECTED ON FINAL APPROVAL IN THE NEAR FUTURE.

ONCE THE PROSPECTUS HAS RECEIVED APPROVAL FROM THE SENATE AND HOUSE PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEES, THE GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION WILL THEN BE FREE TO BEGIN FORMAL SITE SELECTION PROCEDURES.

INAM PLEASED THAT THIS STEP TOWARD THE TOPEKA BUILDINGS REALIZATION HAS BEEN TAKEN. IT MEANS WE ARE EVEN CLOSER TO CULMINATION OF OVER A YEAR'S EFFORT BY LOCAL AND FEDERAL OFFICIALS.
