WASHINGTON, D.C. -- I have been informed that final approval for the new Federal Building in Topeka has been granted by the Senate Public Works Committee today.

However, I must express some disappointment that so far the House and failed to act, and at the moment the prospectus for the Federal Building still remains in the House Public Works Subcommittee on Public Buildings and Grounds. This remains the only obstacle, and of course, once the House Public Works Committee grants its approval GSA will be free to make a formal site selection.
