WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson have written a joint letter to the Chairmen of both the House and Senate Interior Subcommittees on Appropriations and to the Bureau of Indian Affairs on behalf of Haskell Indian Junior College. Both Senators support the Haskell Board of Regent's request that every effort be made to increase the allocation of funds, so that the school may continue at present operating levels. Dole and Pearson are hopeful that action on this request will be forthcoming in the near future.
