WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole announced today that he has received assurances from George Stafford, Chairman of the Interstate Commerce Commission, that additional freight cars will be sent in the near future to the northwestern counties of Cheyenne and Rawlins to h. p alleviate the critical shortage now affecting that area. Farmers have been unable to ship wheat from last year's harvest, to h. p make room for this year's crop, and it is hoped that these additional cars will help to ease pressures on grain storage facilities.
