WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole announced today that he had learned that the Department of Labor will award funds totaling \$58,790, to extend three Operation Mainstream projects in Kansas.

Operation Mainstream gives job experience to adult workers, primarily from rural areas, who have suffered chronic unemployment.

A grant of \$23,060 was awarded to the Economic Opportunity Foundation in Kansas City, which now has 18 OM enrollees. St. Xavier's School in Junction City was awarded \$15,060 for its program serving 10 enrollees. And the City of Wichita received \$20,850 to continue its program for 26 workers.
