WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senators Bob Dole and James announced today that the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare has awarded \$70,819 in additional funds for Kansas universities participating in the Health Professions Students Loan and Scholarship program, for fiscal year 1974.

The new allocations are made under a continuing resolution passed by Congress on June 30, and bring the total allocations to Kansas schools under the Health Professions program to \$514,640.

Additional grants of \$45,220 will be made to the Kansas University School of Medicine at Kansas City, bringing its total funding to \$275,888; of \$25,622 to Kansas State University School of Veterinary Medicine, bringing its total funding to \$156,649. Total funding under the Health Professions Student Loan and Scholarship Program at the University of Kansas School of Pharmacy will be \$82,103, bringing the total for all three schools to slightly over a half million dollars.

Funds awarded to the schools under this program are allocated to the students on the basis of financial need.
