WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced HEW approval of grants totaling \$155,000 worth of Cooperative Education funds to Kansas Institutions of Higher Education. Recipients of the grants are:

- \$23,000 -- Seward County Community Jr. College, Liberal
 - \$22,000 -- Baker University, Baldwin City
 - \$25,000 -- Donnelly College, Kansas City, Ks.
 - \$25,000 -- Bethany College, Lindsborg
 - \$20,000 -- Bethany College, Lindsborg
 - \$25,000 -- Hesston College, Hesston
 - \$15,000 -- Kansas State College of Pittsburgh, Pittsburgh
- Cooperative education encourages the development of college programs

which involve intermitent periods of full-time study and full-time work. Employment for students is located by the school and must be in the area of the student's scholastic or career endeavor. In many instances the student is also given academic credit for completion of a successful period of employment. Goals of the program are to facilitate early career determination and to encourage a practical and career oriented education program.
