GRANT AWARD TO KANSAS STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (\$584,526)

WASHINGTON, D.C. Senator Bob Dole announced Wednesday the awarding of a \$584,526 Department of Health, Education, and Welfare grant to Kansas State Department of Education, Topeka. The funds will be used to help operate programs for migrant children. The main objective of the Kansas migrant program will be to improve the educational attainment of these children. Qualified bilingual and bicultural teachers and aides will be used in the areas of communication, math, culture, music, physical education, health and vocational subjects. Instruction will be offered in prekindergarten through the secondary level.
