## 18 KANSAS COUNTIES ADDED TO DISASTER LIST, ORIGINAL DECLARATION EXTENDED

Kansas City, Kansas -- Senator Bob Dole announced today from his Kansas City Office that some 18 Kansas Counties had been added to the list of those eligible for federal disaster assistance. In addition, Dole said the original disaster declaration for Kansas had been extended to cover damage occurring as a result of last week's heavy rains and flooding. Dole learned of the action, taken by the Federal Disaster Assistance Administration in Washington this afternoon, upon returning to his Kansas City Office after touring storm damaged areas in Kansas City.

Dole said the original federal disaster declaration for Kansas had covered the period from the 29th of September to the 5th of October. Some 32 counties were included under this declaration. Today's action extends that period to cover subsequent damage from last week's flooding and brings the total number of Kansas counties now eligible to 50.
