Loan applications may be received through December 21, 1973 for physical losses and through July 2, 1974 for production losses from eligible farmers. Loans will be made available at a 5 per cent interest rate for those applicants who are unable to obtain credit elsewhere. Individuals desiring information about emergency loans should get in touch with the local County Supervisor of the Farmers Home Administration serving their county.
