## REA TELEPHONE BANK LOAN TO HAVILAND TELEPHONE COMPANY

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced the awarding of a \$1,000,650 Rural Telephone Bank loan to Haviland Telephone Company, Haviland, Kansas.
