THE SCHOOL LUNCH BILL WAS SIGNED INTO LAW THIS AFTERNOON ASSURING THAT SOME 94 KANSAS SCHOOL DISTRICTS WILL RECEIVE FEDERAL IMPACT AID MONEY THIS YEAR.

THE BILL CONTAINED MY AMENDMENT RESTORING ALMOST 8 MILLION DOLLARS TO KANSAS DISTRICTS WHICH HAD BEEN FOUND INELIGIBLE FOR THE AID LAST SEPTEMBER. IN ADDITION, OF COURSE, THE BILL PROVIDES MUCH NEEDED ASSISTANCE TO STATE SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAMS WHICH IN KANSAS SERVE MORE THAN A QUARTER MILLION CHILDREN DAILY.

BUT I AM PARTICULARLY PLEASED THAT WE WERE SUCCESSFUL IN GETTING MY IMPACT AID AMENDMENT SIGNED INTO LAW, SO THAT NEITHER THE SCHOOL CHILDREN, NOR THE TAXPAYERS OF KANSAS, WOULD HAVE TO SUFFER BECAUSE OF A LEGAL TECHNICALITY.

I HAVE BEEN ASSURED BY OFFICIALS AT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, EDUCATION AND WELFARE THAT THE APPLICATION FROM FORT LEAVENWORTH WILL BE HAND PROCESSED AND THAT THE IMPACT AID CHECK SHOULD BE IN THE HANDS OF LOCAL SCHOOL OFFICIALS WITHIN THE NEXT TWO WEEKS.
