SPECIAL REVENUE SHARING PAYMENTS RELEASED

WASHINGTON, D.C.-- Senator Bob Dole today announced the special payment of \$968,459 in revenue sharing funds to 342 units of local government in Kansas.

This special payment is being made to those jurisdictions who had missed the first quarter allocation of 1974 revenue sharing monies because reports on uses and planned uses had been received after the September 25 reporting deadline.
