## OEO GRANT TO GARDEN CITY

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson and Congressman Keith Sebelius today announced an \$11,700 grant from the Office of Economic Opportunity to the Kansas Council for Agricultural Workers and Low Income Families, based in Garden City.

The grant funds will be used to provide for the administration and management of the community action agency and to administer and coordinate programs funded by other agencies to deliver services to the migrant and low-income families.

Fred Banda will be project director for the grant that will run for three months beginning January 1, 1974. The project will serve Finney, Greeley, Grant, Kearney, Scott, Sherman, Stanton, Wallace, Wichita, and Haskell counties.
