DOLE ANNOUNCES ELDERLY OUTREACH PROGRAM

washington, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole announced the kickoff of a massive Federal outreach program to identify an estimated 50,000 aged, blind and disabled Kansans who will become eligible for assistance under the Supplementary Security Income Program when it becomes effective in January, 1974. The SSI program is the federally administered program which will replace state and local public assistance payments to the aged, blind and disabled.

The Administration on Aging last week made available to the State of Kansas a \$95,000 grant to fund the volunteer effort through the State Agencies on Aging. In Kansas, volunteers from the National Association of Retired Federal Employees, the American Association of Retired Persons, the National Council on Aging, and the National Caucus on the Black Aged will coordinate their efforts with the Red Cross to disseminate information about the Supplemental Security Income Program and work to assure that those eligible for payments have an opportunity to apply.

The Supplementary Security Income Program establishes a national income floor for the aged, the blind and the disabled. The guaranteed monthly income level is \$130 for an individual and \$195 for a couple. Kansans interested in the program or who feel they may be eligible for payments should contact the Social Security Offices at the following locations.
