JOBS FOR PROGRESS RECEIVES FUNDS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole today announced Department of Labor and Office of Economic Opportunity grants totalling \$41,550 to Kansas City SER-Jobs for Progress.

The funding will enable SER Jobs for Progress to open an office on January I in the Armourdale area of Kansas City, Kansas. It will provide job training for community residents who have no job skills to offer an employer. While the client is undergoing training, a job edeveloper will be out in the field identifying and developing jobs for the individuals undergoing training.
