WASHINGTON, D.C. - Senator Bob Dole today sent a telegram to President Nixon urging prompt signature of the 1974 L-HEW Appropriation Bill, which yesterday received final Congressional approval and is now awaiting the President's signature.

Dole indicated that he felt Congress had acted very reasonably on this year's Appropriation Bill and that the measure was well within the budget ceiling established at the beginning of the year. Dole said it is especially important to Kansas students and educators that the bill become law since we are already in the middle of the school year, and the federal share of school budgets has not yet been determined.

The L-HEW Appropriation Bill provides 1974 funds for education programs from pre-school to college. It funds student assistance programs, school construction, the impact aid programs, and a variety of other educational and health programs.
