MANPOWER GRANT TO KANSAS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced a \$292,820 Manpower Administration grant to the State of Kansas to fund its ongoing Public Service Careers program for another year.

This grant from the Labor Department will provide training for more than 300 PSC enrollees in governmental and public service agencies in the state.

The goal of the PSC program is to develop enrollees, primarily disadvantaged workers, for jobs in the public sector. The grant will fund training for 265 enrollees entering PSC jobs and 61 whose positions are being upgraded.
