EMERGENCY CONSERVATION ASSISTANCE FOR 16 KANSAS COUNTIES

WASHINGTON, D.C.—Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson and Congressmen†Keith Sebelius, Garner Shriver, and Joe Skubitz today announced Department of Agriculture emergency conservation assistance to 16 Kansas counties to help repair damage caused by flooding during September and October, 1973.

An initial allocation of \$300,000 was made available to the Kansas State

Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Committee. The funds will be used in

sharing with farmers in the designated counties the cost of removing debris from

farmland, grading and shaping eroded land areas, and restoring farm structures

such as farm ponds, terraces and sod waterways.

The 16 counties affected are Clay, Cloud, Cowley, Doniphan, Edwards, Ellsworth Harper, Harvey, Kingman, McPherson, Ottawa, Reno, Rice, Saline, Sedwick, and Washington.
