NEW FOREIGN TRADE ZONE AUTHORIZED FOR KANSAS CITY, KANSAS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson and Congressman Larry Winn today announced authorization for establishment of a general purpose Foreign Trade Zone in Kansas City, Kansas.

The zone will be located in an underground warehouse facility operated by Inland Center, 6500 Inland Drive. It is intended to assist firms engaged in international trade-related activities where high customs costs are involved.

This is the third site to be designated as a Foreign Trade Zone in the Kansas City area.
