SEK-CAP INC. TO RECEIVE GRANT

WASHINGTON, D.C.— Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson and Congressman Joe Skubitz today announced a \$36,000 Office of Economic Opportunity grant to Sek-Cap, Inc. of Girard Kansas. This Senior Opportunities and Services grant will be used to provide for the needs of the elderly poor with projects which serve or employ olderpepersons, to operate a home feeding program serving 50 homebound elderly, to obtain volunteers to deliver meals and to operate a rural bus route to bring participants into urban centers to obtain goods and services.

The project will serve Allen, Bourbon, Linn, Crawford, Cherokee, Labette and Montgomery counties. The grant will be effective as of January I, 1974 and will run for six months.

Project Director is James W. Garrison.
