OEO GRANT TO KANSAS

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson announced today that the Office of Economic Opportunity in Washington has awarded a grant of \$50,000 to the Kansas State Economic Opportunity Office in Topeka.

The purpose of the grant is to provide technical assistance to all community action agencies in mobilizing and allocating resources and to provide training to the CAA staffs and boards, and to provide assistance to state government in focusing and co-ordinating anti-poverty activities.
