IMPACT AID MONEY TO TOPEKA SCHOOLS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole announced through his Washington office today, that \$76,794. has been certified by the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare for immediate payment to Unified School District No. 437.

This money is made available through Title I of Public Law 874 which provides financial assistance for shcools in federally affected areas. An amendment added by Dole to the School Lunch Bill made 94 federally impacted Kansas school districts eligible for federal payments during 1974. Kansas had previously been found ineleigible for federal impact aid funds by the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare.

Additional payments could be made available to the school district if actual data shows that such adjustment is necessary. Tentative entitlement for the district is \$153,589.
