ENERGY STAFF TO MEET WITH WAMEGO RESIDENTS AT DOLE'S REQUEST

TOPEKA---Senator Bob Dole announced today that a Wednesday meeting will be held between officials of the Regional Federal Energy Office and citizens from the city of Wamego, Kansas, to discuss the shortage of fuel there.

The meeting was arranged when Dole learned that Wamego has been especially hard hit by severe curtailments of fuel for the town's service stations and bulk dealers. Unless relief is found, school buses and other essential services and businesses may have to be stopped due to the lack of fuel at each of the city's sources of supply.

Attending the meeting from the Federal Energy Office will be James Newman, Director of the Regional Energy Office, Robert Walker, Operations Director and Dick Challinor, Public Information Officer. From Wamego, members of the Chamber of Commerce, the School Board, and the City Commission, and service station operators, businessmen and citizens affected by the shortage will be present. A representative of Senator Dole will also be present.

The meeting will be held at 10:00 AM, Wednesday January 23, 1973, in the Chief's Room, Ramada Inn, Kansas City, Kansas.
