WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole today announced that a supply of gasoline has been provided for the school buses of Unified School District #395 in Rush county.

When Dole was in LaCrosse last week, Eli Boucher, superintendent of the school district, told the Senator that the gas supplier for the buses that service Alexander and McCracken would soon be unable to provide them enough fuel to keep the school buses running.
