IMPACT AID MONEY TO SALINA SCHOOLS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced that the Department of Health, Education and Welfare has certified \$266,141 for immediate payment to Unified School District No. 305 in Salina.

This money is made available through Title I of Public Law 874 which provides financial assistance for schools in federally affected areas. An amendment added by Dole to the School Lunch Bill made 94 federally impacted Kansas school districts eligible for federal payments during 1974. Kansas had previously been found ineligible for federal impact aid funds by the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare.

Additional payments could be made available to the school district if actual data shows that such adjustment is necessary.
