FUNDS NOW ALLOTED FOR KANSAS EDUCATION

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson announced today that the Department of Health, Education and Welfare had informed them of the allocation figures for funding of programs in Kansas under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, Title I.

The total funding amounts to \$11,756,126 for the entire state and is broken down by programs as follows: Local Educational Agencies \$9,631,973; Handicapped Children (State Agencies), \$1,102,617; Juvenile Delinquents in Institutions (State Agencies), \$139, 853; Delinquents in Correctional Institutions (State Agencies), \$85,209; Migratory Children (State Agency) \$646,474; State Administration, \$150,000.
