WICHITA DESIGNATED AS PORT OF ENTRY

RUSSELL, KANSAS--Senator Bob Dole, commenting on the announcement that final approval had been granted for the designation of Wichita as a port of entry, praised the work and tenacity of the Wichita business community.

"This is a matter that Congressman Shriver and I have been working on for some time," Dole said, "but the real credit goes to those in the Wichita area whose efforts ultimately made this designation possible. Wichita is the center of a vast trading area which covers much of Kansas and impacts on other states as well. Its designation as a port of entry recognizes the important economic position of the city and should considerably enhance the economy of the whole area."
