FEO WILL ORDER FUEL FOR FAMLAND INDUSTRIES

WICHITA, KANSAS -- Senator Bob Dole announced today that pending approval from the Coordinating Center in Dallas, Texas, the Federal Energy Office in Kansas City will send orders allocating 3.6 million gallons of gas and 2.095 gallons of distillates to Farmland Industries. In order to resolve a large part of the fuel requirements of Farmland Industries, some customers will be reassigned to other oil companies for a supply of fuel.

This action comes after a meeting Dole arranged on February 4 between himself, William Simon, head of the Federal Energy Office, and representatives of Farmland Industries.
