KANSAS ALLOTMENT FOR EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS INCREASED

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced that the Department of Health, Education and Welfare had increased Kansas's allotment ^{for} instructional materials by \$856,129, making the total allotment \$930,912.

The money is allotted for the acquisition of school library resources, textbooks, and other printed and published instructional materials for the use of children and teachers in the public and private elementary and secondary schools, and for administration of the program.
