## NEW MEMBER NAMED TO KANSAS ASC COMMITTEE

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole today announced the appointment of Melvin Earl Bunge of Waverly as a member of the Kansas Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation (ASC) committee. ASC committeemen are responsible for state administration of farm action programs.

The 52-year old Coffey county farmer owns and operates a 920-acre farm devoted primarily to wheat, corn, soybeans and hay. He is a graduate of Kansas State University and has been self-employed as a farmer since 1942.

Other members of the state ASC committee are Lavern H. Becker of Russell, chairman, and Harlan D. House of Edson. Dr. Robert A. Bohannon, director of the state Agricultural Extension Service, is an ex-officio member.

Bunge is a member of the Kansas Farm Bureau, Waverly Chamber of Commerce and Lions Club, County Planning Board, and has just completed serving 16 years on the local school board.
