SENATE APPROVES KANSAS PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--The Senate today gave final Congresional approval to the 1973
Water Resources Act which included legislation sponsored by Senator Bob Dole authorizing
\$500,000 for road improvements in the vacinity of Melvern and Pomona Lakes in Osage
County, construction of a new bridge on the Vermillion River in Poltawatomie County and
\$500,000 for improvements on FAS route 1208 near Tuttle Creek Lake.

The House of Representatives approved the conference report of the bill on Tuesday and today's Senate action constitutes the final step in the Congressional approval process. The bill now goes to the President for his signiture.

Commenting on Congressional approval, Dole said, "The problem of providing safe and adequate acess to federal lakes in Kansas has become critical in recent years. Local resources are usually inadequate to meet the whole problem so I believe it is appropriate for the Federal government to step in and provide the assistance."
