KANSAS PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS BECOME LAW

WASHINGTON, D.C. President Nixon today signed the 1973 Water Resources

Act which included legislation sponsored by Senator Bob Dole authorizing \$500,000

for road improvements in the vicinity of Melvern and Pomona Lakes in Osage County,

construction of a new bridge on the Vermillion River in Pottawatomie County and

\$500,000 for improvements on FAS route 1208 near Tuttle Creek Lake.

Commenting on approval, Dole said, "This is a significant measure for Kansas. The problem of providing safe and adequate roads near federal lakes in Kansas has become critical in recent years. Local resources are usually inadequate to meet the whole problem so I believe it is appropriate for the Federal government to step in and provide the assistance."
