## IMPACT AID MONEY FOR KANSAS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced throught their Washington offices that checks totalling \$128,837 had been mailed to Kansas communities qualifying for impact aid funds by the Department of Health, Education and Welfare.

HEW had previously declared Kansas ineligible for impact aid funds under Title I of PL 874. A Dole amendment to the School Lunch Bill enabled Kansas communities to qualify for the funds.

Following are amounts each district will recieve. Additional payments to districts may be forthcoming if actual data shows they are necessary.
