WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole conferred this morning with Alexander P. Butterfield, Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration, to discuss the Manhattan Flight Service Station. Dole plans to meet later today with other FAA officials on the same matter.

Saying he was strongly opposed to closing any flight service stations in Kansas, Dole added,"In my view, a number of steps should be taken to strengthen the Manhattan Flight Service Station, rather than weaken it."
