KANSAN TO BE NAMED TO NATIONAL COMMITTEE

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole announced today that Earl Brookover, Garden City, Kansas, will be anmed to a two-year term on the National Cattle Industry Advisory Committee.

The committee advises the Secretary of Agriculture on several areas important to the cattle industry including: (1) imports of beef and veal and live animals and their effect on the domestic economy; (2) international trade negotiations pertaining to beef and related products; (3) activities designed to affect the domestic consumption of beef and veal, including departmental purchasing programs; (4) policy relating to feeding and other production practices; and (5) other conditions and developments relating to rattle prices, production and marketing.

"Earl Brookover is a leader in the cattle industry," Dole commented, "and he will bring to the committee experience and knowledge that will be of great value to the Secretary in his actions affecting this important industry."

The committee meets once or twice a year as determined by the Secretary of Agriculture, depending on economic situations.
