OVER \$1 MILLION IN IMPACT AID FOR KANSAS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced that \$1,043,823 has been certified for immediate paymnet to four Kansas school districts by the Department of Health, Education and Welfare.

This money is made available through Title I of Public law 874 which provides financial assistance to schools in federally affected areas. An amendment added by Dole to the School Lunch Bill made 94 federally impacted Kansas School districts eligible for federal payments during 1974. Kansas had previously been found ineligible for federal impact aid funds by the Department of Health Education and Welfare. Earlier this week \$66,896 had been certified for payment for five other Kansas School districts.
