HEW GRANT TO CAPPER FOUNDATION

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced, through their Washington offices, a \$68,250 grant to the Capper Foundation for Crippled Children from the Department of Health, Education and Welfare.

The grant will be used in funding of a project titled Observation Recording of Performance in the Early Intervention of Preprimary Physically Handicapped Children. This grant covers the first budget period of a project period which is tentatively planned for three years. Upon showing of satisfactory progress towards the achievement of the goals of the project, the U.S. Office of Education will consider the continued funding of the project.
