REIMBURSEMENT GRANTS FOR KANSAS EPA PROJECTS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced, through their Washington offices, a ______ reimbursement grant toom ______ from the Environmental Protection Agency. The grant is awarded under an EPA program that provides federal funds to those sewer projects contructed between 1966 and 1972 which received only 30% federal funding at the time of construction.

Nearly 125 Kansas projects will be eligible for approximately \$5.5 million in reimbursements over the coming months. The reimbursements are being awarded under authority established in the 1972 Water Pollution Control Amendments.
