HEADSTART GRANT TO SERVE FIVE KANSAS COUNTIES

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced a \$131,556 Headstart grant that will serve 117 children in five Kansas counties. The funds, which will be administered through Nek-Cap, Inc. of Norton will be used in Headstart centers in Atchison, Brown, Doniphan, Jackson and Nemaha counties.

The 117 children are from low-income families and will be serviced on a part-day basis. Project director for the grant, which will run 12 months, is Bill Metcalf.
