DOLE STRESSES NEED TO CONTROL INFLATION

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole today commended new Treasury Secretary William Simon for his views on the importance of controlling inflation.

"It is most encouraging to note in your Senate confirmation hearings and public statements that you rank control of inflation as your first priority in your new job. This echoes my belief that inflation is the number one domestic problem facing America today." Senator Dole said.
