\$107,104 IN IMPACT AID FUNDS TO SERVE 12 KANSAS SCHOOL DISTRICTS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced that the Department of Health, Education and Welfare has certified \$107,104 for immediate payment to 12 Kansas school districts in federally affected areas.

This money is made available through Title I of Public law 874 which provides financial assistance to schools in federally affected areas. An amendment added by Dole to the School Lunch Bill made 94 federally impacted Kansas school districts eligible for federal payments during 1974. Kansas had previously been found ineligible for federal impact aid funds by the Department of Health, Education and Welfare.
