EPA REIMBURSEMENT GRANTS TOTAL \$898,600 FOR 20 KANSAS PROJECTS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced twenty Environmental Protection Agency reimbursement grants for twenty Kansas EPA projects. The grants are awarded under an EPA program that provides federal funds to those sewer projects constructed between 1966 and 1972 which received a lesser amount of federal funding at the time of construction than is being awarded to comparable projects now.

Today's reimbursements bring the total of grants to Kansas for these projects to \$2,529,400,
