ST. MARYS NOW ELIGIBLE FOR FLOOD INSURANCE

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson have announced that St. Marys is now eligible for flood insurance that is subsidized through the Department of Housing and Urban Development. Beginning May 30, all structures used for residential, business, religious, or agricultural purposes, structures occupied by nonprofit organizations, and structures owned by State or local governments or agencies thereof are eligible for flood insurance coverage.

St. Mary's became qualified under this program when it agreed to adopt land use and control measures that will minimize flood damage to future construction. Local insurance agents may obtain policies and other information from the National Flood Insurers Association servicing office, which is the Royal-Globe Insurance Companies, 1125 Grand Avenue, Kansas City, Missouri 64141.
